The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 68 dated 13.04.2019 under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City South, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that, she while entering into an agreement to sell her motorcycle with the complainant had not disclosed that the motorcycle is hypothecated with the bank. He also contends that the petitioner is a lady of 24 years of age.

This Court, by the order dated 30.04.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the even of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI-Gurvinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 30.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
