The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 4 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.5 and 6, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Sushil Kumar has apprised the Court that the statements of respondents No.5 and 6 (parents of petitioner No.1) have been recorded, wherein they have expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. It

has been assured that they shall not interfere in the married life of petitioners. The copies of the statements have been produced.

Learned counsel has reiterated the stand of the respondents before the Court today.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that still there is existence of threat, however, he is unable to substantiate his arguments with any convincing material.

In view of the above, when the alleged threat has vanished, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. in this matter.

The petition is hereby dismissed.
