The prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ of *Mandamus*, directing the respondent-Bank for accepting the proposal and release the residential house as the petitioner is ready to repay the loan amount as per Annexure P-1.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
