The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.1441 dated 17.12.2018, under Sections 323, 325, 34, 341 and 506 IPC and later on added offence under Section 3 (2) (v) (A) of SC and ST Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is alleged to have given blow of the reverse side of axe on the left hand of the complainant, who has fully recovered from that injury. The allegations in the FIR do not *prima facie* constitute an offence under SC and ST Act. The petitioner is in custody for over four months. He also contends that co-accused of the petitioner, namely Ankit Kumar and Smt.Sehjadi have been granted concession of regular bail by this Court/a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-9491 of 2019 on 10.4.2019 and CRM-M-11174 of 2019 on 19.3.2019 respectively.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mahinder Singh states that investigation of the case has been completed but no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over four months, other co-accused have been granted the concession of regular bail and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant him regular bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
