1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 9.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and requisite sets of paper-book has been supplied to her.
4. The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age

petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 8.11.1992 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 28.11.1991. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

5. Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and validity of marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

6. Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
