Vide this order, CRM-M-40846, 41812, 43166, 43193 and 43422 of 2018 shall stand disposed of.

In all these petitions, prayer is made to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner(s) and for issuance of directions to the police not to harass the petitioners.

ASI Charan Singh, Investigating Officer present in Court has submitted that none of the petitioner in all these 5 cases is involved in the criminal offence in FIR No.182 dated 25.08.2018 registered under Sections 302, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural). He has further informed the Court that two accused have been arrested whereas proceedings for declaring remaining two accused as proclaimed offender have been initiated. He has further submitted that the police after investigation has not been able to find any material against 7 accused as named by the first informant. He has further informed the Court that the parties had in fact settled their dispute.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts as well as statement of the Investigating Officer that the petitioners are not required in FIR No.182 dated 25.08.2018, all the petitions are disposed of, having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner(s) to move an application for revival, if the facts are otherwise.
