This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 15.10.2018 passed in CWP No. 26502 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of by giving directions to the respondents/Authorities to look into the legal notice of the petitioners (Annexure P-8) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of 6 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order."

Learned State counsel has produced order dated 24.5.2019 wherein the stepping up of the salary of petitioners have been done to bring them at par with their juniors. The same is taken on record, copy handed over to counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Madan Lal, Superintendent and Ashok Kumar, Assistant states that arrears have also

been paid to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law if still some grievance survives.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

In case there is some discrepancy found in the statement made today in Court, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
