FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 10.10.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Kirti Janghu and the accused persons, namely, Ashish Kumar, Satbiri, Jagmer Singh and Archana Singh alias Meenu, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

A bare perusal of the records as well as the above said report received from the Court below reveals that the parties have given final effect to their agreement settlement/compromise and that nothing is due towards anyone on account of this settlement.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offenses for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.170 dated 27.03.2015 under Sections 406, 498A, 506, 34 IPC pertaining to Police Station Sector 5, Gurugram and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands disposed off in those terms.
