This petition has been filed for seeking direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners.

On the last date the following order was passed:-

“Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and Mr. Dinesh Trehan, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents No. 4 and 5 and requisite sets of paper-book be supplied to them during the course of the day.

Counsel for the respondents No.4 and 5-parents of petitioner No.1 states that respondent No.5 - mother of

petitioner No.1 may be allowed to meet petitioner No.1. Request has been accepted. She has met with the petitioner No.1 in the Chamber of this Court. Even thereafter the daughter-petitioner No.1 is adamant that she wants to live with the boy petitioner No.2. Counsel for the respondents No.4 and 5 states his client has no objection to this marriage but to secure the future of the petitioner No.1, petitioner No.2 may be directed to make a FDR (fixed deposit) of three years of Rs. 1 lakh in favour of petitioner No.1. Counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No.2 has no objection to this course of action and undertakes to make a FDR of three years of Rs. 1 lakh in favor of petitioner No.1.

The case is adjourned to 13.5.2019. In the meantime, respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to take appropriate steps to protect life and liberty of the petitioners. Further, petitioner No.2 is directed to bring the FDR amounting to Rs. 1 lakh of three years in favour of petitioner No.1 on the next date of hearing.”

Today the counsel for the petitioners has shown the court a FDR No.856335 dated 10.05.2019 of Rs.1 lakh for a period of three years.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
