HARI PAL VERMA, J.

The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 439(2) Cr.PC for cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 14.06.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sonipat in case bearing FIR No.155 dated 23.03.2018 under Sections 323, 354, 377, 406, 498-A and 506 IPC registered at Police Station City Gohana, District Sonipat.

Perusal of the paper book reveals that initially, respondent No.2 filed a petition i.e. ***CRM-M-19198 of 2018*** titled as ***Parvesh Versus State of Haryana*** under Section 438 Cr.PC seeking anticipatory bail, but the same was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 23.05.2018. Therefore, he surrendered before the trial Court on 28.05.2018 and it is by virtue of impugned order dated 14.06.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sonipat, he was admitted on regular bail.

So far as the allegations levelled against respondent No.2 in the FIR are concerned, this Court finds that the same are required to be adjudicated during trial. Therefore, no ground is made out for cancellation of regular bail granted to respondent No.2.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
