The grievance of the petitioner herein is that he has not been given the benefit of his previous regular service rendered as Lecturer in Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, Kotkapura, after his regular appointment as Lecturer in Government Rajindra College, Bhatinda vide appointment letter dated 10.12.1996(Annexure P-2). Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was originally appointed as Lecturer in previous college on 08.07.1989 where he served up to 14.12.1996. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the instructions dated 15.11.2000(Annexure P-6). He also relies on the judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No. 5615 of 2001 dated 10.03.2016 contained at Annexure P-11 issued by the State Government and yet the benefit is not accorded to him. In the premise, the petitioner also caused a legal notice dated 22.10.2018(Annexure P-20) which too was not adverted by the respondents. Hence this petition.

Given the nature of order being passed and keeping in view the aforesaid, no further proceedings or pleadings are warranted in this case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass a speaking order by objectively considering the contentions as raised in the legal notice dated 22.10.2018(Annexure P-20) along with the contents of the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation as also keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioners, as noted above, in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In the event the petitioner is found entitled to the benefits, as claimed by him, the same be accorded to him within a period of two months thereafter.
