This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.293 dated 19.08.2018 registered under Sections 21/22-C/27 NDPS Act at Police Station Old Subji Mandi, Rohtak

On 28.09.2018 the following order was passed:-

“Adjourned to 18.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rohtash Singh accepts the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 28.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
