Prayer in this petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for releasing the petitioners from Safe House, i.e. under the custody of Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh.

Brief facts of the case are that on an earlier occasion, the petitioners have filed a petition bearing CRM-M-16021-2019, which was disposed of on 11.04.2019 with a direction to respondent No. 2 to provide protection to the petitioners, if so required. In pursuance thereof, when the petitioners approached respondent No. 2, they were kept in the Safe House.

Now, the petitioners have filed the present petition seeking direction to respondent No. 2 to release them as they have compromised the matter with the private respondents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdeep Singh, submits that they have no objection in case the petitioners are released from the Safe House.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of and respondent No. 2, Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh, is directed to release the petitioners from the Safe House/police protection.
