Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to learned trial Court to decide the cross-cases i.e. FIR No.64 dated 13.03.2011, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 427, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Butana and Complaint Case No.25 of 2011, titled as '**Ravi Kumar Versus Daulat Ram and others**' simultaneously as per the procedure of Section 223 Cr.P.C.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the order of even date, passed in connected case bearing CRM-M No.32372 of 2016, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

Clarified that in case any fresh order, adverse to the interest of the petitioner, is passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, he would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
