This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to trace out and produce detainee Kamlesh Kaur, wife of the petitioner, who has been illegally confined by respondent No.4 Gurpreet Singh.

Notice of motion was issued. Respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station City Meharban, Ludhiana was directed to visit the given address of respondent No. 4 and inquire into as to whether detainee-Kamlesh Kaur has been confined illegally and against her wishes by respondent No.4. If it is found so, then she be produced immediately before this Court. Otherwise, a detailed report be submitted on the date fixed.

Reply by way of affidavit of SHO, Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana respondent No.3 has been filed. Same is taken on record.

Alleged detainee Kamlesh Kaur is present in the Court and she

made the statement before this Court that she was residing with respondent No.4 Gurpreet Singh as per her own wish. He has not illegally detained her against her wishes. She further states that petitioner Jagjit Singh is her husband, but she was residing with respondent No.4 Gurpreet Singh as per her own consent.

Keeping in view the statement of detenue Kamlesh Kaur, no further action is required in this matter.

Disposed of accordingly.
