AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 17.9.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 23638 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without commenting on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to direct the official respondents to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order, as expeditiously as possible. Ordered accordingly.”

Short reply dated 19.8.2019 by way of an affidavit of Amit Gupta, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ferozepur filed in Court today annexing the order dated 28.11.2018 is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, liberty is sought to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 28.11.2018.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
