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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No. 342, dated 2.8.2016, registered under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, at P.S. Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

The allegations in FIR are that one Harpreet Singh alias Ganja, who was under trial in a case, had been admitted in emergency ward in Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar. 3 persons namely, Ranjodh Singh, Sanju and Jaswinder Singh made an attempt to forcibly take away said Harpreet Singh alias Ganja. They fired at police party. However, the attempt was unsuccessful. The police retaliated and accused persons fled away from there with their respective weapons.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner has not been named in FIR. His name came up on disclosure statement made by co accused. All main accused have already been released on bail. The petitioner is in custody since 31.8.2018. The investigation in the case is complete. The trial has commenced.

Without commenting anything on merit of case and also bearing in mind the fact that petitioner is in custody since 31.8.2018, no useful purpose would be served by keeping her behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing

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bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, if petitioner indulges in any activity of similar nature, while on bail, prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek cancellation of order granting bail to petitioner.
