GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.524 dated 31.5.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Karnal, District Karnal and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 16.11.2018 the parties had been directed to appear

before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainants-Pinki, Baby and Babli have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainants have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal that the compromise seems to be genuine.
4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.524 dated 31.5.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Karnal, District Karnal and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
