The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 38, dated 17.03.2018, under Sections 148/149/323/506 of IPC (Section 307 IPC added lateron) registered at P.S. Hassanpur, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a sudeden dispute arose between the parties while they were playing cricket and it is alleged that the petitioner had hit the injured with a cricket bat on his head. He also states that the petitioner is 23 years old and he is not involved in any other case. He is in custody since 04.04.2018 and the conclusion of the trial will take some time.

Learned State counsel states that seven out of sixteen prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2018, I deem it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of regular bail as the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
