Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Shiv Bhagwan, Deputy Ranger, O/0 DFO, Jhajjar, submits that the petitioner has been regularised as per the policy of 1996 and the monetary benefits due to him would be credited in his account within eight weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition. He further submits that calculation of the amount due be also given to the petitioner and seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law in case any grievance still survives.
