FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Mukhtar Singh and Rajbir Kaur in case registered by way of FIR No.158 dated 02.08.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 120-B IPC pertaining to Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners Mr. Veneet Sharma submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 19.09.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further

investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 19.09.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan) and thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
