The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.1082 dated 26.10.2018, under Sections 307, 147, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is the case of no injury and the co-accused is stated to have fired a shot but it did not hit anyone. He is in custody for over 7 months since his arrest on 28.10.2018.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Om Parkash, states that the petitioner was riding the motorcycle on which the co-accused was travelling. No witness out of the total 19 prosecution witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially, when it is a case of no injury, no specific

role has been attributed to the petitioner and, he is in custody over 7 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time , I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
