This order shall dispose of above mentioned two petitions bearing No. **CRM-M-40311-2017** titled as ***Jaswinder Singh Versus State of Punjab and others*** and **CRM-M-42848-2017** titled as ***Jaswinder Singh Versus State of Punjab and others***, as the common question of law and facts arises in both the petitions. For brevity, the facts are being taken from **CRM-M-40311-2017**.

Heard.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for direction to respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner from respondent No. 3 who is levelling false allegations

against him. Though the inquiry in the application is found to be false but no action under Section 182 of the Indian Penal Code has been taken against respondent No. 3.

In the circumstances, both petitions are disposed of with direction to official respondents to consider the application(s) filed earlier which were found to be filed and that in case, in future, any application is filed against the complainant-petitioner, preliminary inquiry will be conducted to look into the truthfulness of the complaint without calling the complainant-petitioner to the police station and if the complaint is found to be false, necessary action will be taken against respondent No. 3.

Disposed of with aforesaid direction.
