“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and directions may kindly be issued to respondent no.2 to take appropriate legal action against respondents no.4 to 6 on the complaint dated 16.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) given by the petitioner.

It is further prayed that respondent no.2 may kindly be directed to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and his family members which is in danger to the hands of respondents no.4 to 7.”

Pursuant to notice, reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police has been filed and it has been submitted as under:-

“3. That it is submitted that an enquiry in the complaint dated 16.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) was conducted by the police and during the enquiry, the allegations levelled by the petitioner was found to be false. Copy of the enquiry report is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1/T.

4. That no illegality or impropriety has been committed by the police in the present matter. The police has acted

in the present matter property. As such, no cause of action has accrued to the petitioner to file the present petition.”

Keeping in view the aforesaid reply, petitioner is relegated to the remedy before the Magistrate.
