Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a cheque bearing No. 027047 dated 27.5.2019 for a sum of Rs.25,000/- in the name of respondent No.2, to learned counsel for the respondent, copy of which is taken on record.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case likely to be registered against him on an application submitted by respondent No.2 against the petitioner husband on 20.4.2019 to SHO, Police Station Women, Hisar.

State has filed reply which shows that no FIR has been registered on the application of respondent No.2 till date. Respondent No.2 gave birth to a girl child on 25.4.2019 and now she does not want to initiate

any action on her complaint.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, this petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4 that if the petitioner is required to be arrested, he be given 2 days prior notice.
