The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.48 dated 16.04.2019 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that 60 bottles of country-made liquor were recovered from the fodder room in the farm of the petitioner. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

This Court, by the order dated 01.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Deepak Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 01.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
