Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.81 dated 13.07.2018 under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

The petitioner is the owner of the car, which was being used for transportation of 24 kgs opium, which was allegedly brought from the State of Manipur.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and appraisal of case file, this Court is of the considered view that in this case, the matter requires intensive investigation and no ground is made out for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner and the present petition stands dismissed.
