By this petition, the petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to retain them as Veterinary Surgeons.

Short reply on behalf of the respondents filed in Court today is taken on record. As per this reply, 280 Veterinary Surgeons were engaged on 23.02.2017 purely on contractual basis under Part-II of the outsourcing policy for one year and 168 Veterinary Surgeons remained on engagement as per order dated 20.02.2018 (Annexure R-1). Thereafter fresh recommendation for 223 Veterinary Surgeons on regular basis was received and majority of the contractually engaged Veterinary Surgeons were got selected as regular. With respect to 82 contractually engaged Veterinary Surgeons, extension for three months was granted w.e.f. 23.02.2019 and 75% of the cattle census work has now been completed and in this backdrop, the petitioners will be relieved.

Keeping in view the above, writ petition is dismissed.

However the petitioners can approach this Court within two months if the petitioners are replaced by another set of contractual

Veterinary Surgeons.
