ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 59 dated 01.07.2018, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that awaiting the report of the FSL, the petitioner was granted interim bail by the trial Court on 01.09.2018, however, after the report of the FSL was received, the petitioner failed to appear and surrender before the trial Court, therefore, his bail/surety bonds were cancelled on 28.03.2019.

Considering the fact that the petitioner was granted concession of interim bail awaiting the report of FSL and has furnished an affidavit that he will surrender before the trial Court as and when the report of FSL is received, however, he did not do so and also in view of the fact that recovery is of 820 tablets of *Alprazolam*, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition stands dismissed.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of seven days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided by the trial Court within a period of one week thereafter.
