The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 213 dated 07.10.2016, under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code and Section 24 of the Immigration Act registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail by the Trial Court and he had been appearing regularly before the Trial Court. However, he could not appear before the trial Court on 11.03.2019, as he was unwell and, therefore, his bail was cancelled. He undertakes that the petitioner shall appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and shall not absent himself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 01.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on ad interim bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned State counsel states that petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail in terms of the order dated 01.05.2019.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner, the order dated 01.05.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
