The petitioner filed a writ petition challenging the order dated 19.10.2010 whereby, the benefit of pension was denied. In the writ petition, the respondents admitted the claim for pensionary benefits. The writ petition was allowed on 14.12.2018 directing the respondents to calculate the amount of interest on the pensionary benefits from the date it became due i.e. 01.11.2011 till the payment of the amount @6% per annum.

The present petition is filed pleading that the needful has not been done by the respondents.

Learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of an affidavit of Mr. Sunder Lal, HFS, Divisional Forest Officer, Rewari, same is taken on record, copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the benefits alongwith interest have been paid to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to contradict

the said fact due to lack of instructions.

There is no reason to disbelieve the reply filed by the respondents.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case the petitioner approaches the respondents, the respondents will supply the details of calculation of amount found due and interest paid and in case of any grievance petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
