This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondent to take action on the representation dated 18.4.2019 (Annexure P-3) made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the sole respondent Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation dated 18.4.2019 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG, Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to sole respondent Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to consider and decide

the representation dated 18.4.2019 (Annexure P-3) within four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of four weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
