The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.352 dated 20.08.2018 under Sections 384, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he had tried to extort money from the complainant. He further contends that the instant FIR is the outcome of a monetary dispute with the complainant, as the complainant could not repay the money borrowed by him from the petitioner and his friends. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. He also contends that co-accused, namely, Vivek @ Vicky Garg has already been granted *ad interim* bail by this Court in CRM-M No.61755 of 2018.

This Court, by order dated 01.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation but a country made pistol is yet to be recovered from him.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 01.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
