GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to ensure protection of his life and liberty and of other members of his family as they apprehend threats to the same at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that his mother- Pushpa Devi has inherited property of her father on the basis of Will dated 11.11.2010 to the exclusion of her brother (respondent No.5). Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that in fact brother of petitioner's mother i.e. respondent No.5- Dhanwant Rai along with his sons and his wife i.e. respondents

No.6 to 8 had been harassing petitioner's grandfather ('Nanna') in order to usurp his property and had initially forced him to execute a Will in favour of respondent No.5, but subsequently the grandfather of the petitioner cancelled the said Will and had executed a fresh Will in favour of the mother of the petitioner. Pursuant to execution of Will dated 11.11.2010 the petitioner's mother had filed a civil suit against her brother but ever-since filing of the said civil suit, respondents No.5 to 8 have been pressurizing petitioner's mother to withdraw the civil suit and to effect compromise.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the veracity of the averments, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously in accordance with law.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from receipt of copy of this order.
