The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 12.9.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana.

Heard.

Learned State counsel for the petitioner states that now the matter has been compromised between the parties and the parties have also filed divorce petition.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Makhan Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
