Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to complete the investigation in case FIR No. 6 dated 04.02.2016, registered under Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1967, Section 31 of the Representation of People Act, 1950, 1951 & 1989 and Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Kathu Nangal, Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that during investigation, petitioner was found innocent and even cancellation report was prepared by the police, but the same has not been submitted before the Court for passing of final order. At any rate, investigation has also not been completed by now. In this regard, petitioner made representation dated 06.02.2018 (Annexure P3) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, which is not decided till date.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, Deputy

Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. A complete copy of paper-book be provided to him during the course of the day.

In view of above, present petition stands disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar to look into the representation dated 06.02.2018 (Annexure P3) and take the required action thereon, as per law.
