The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.72, dated 29.06.2018, registered under Sections 307, 323, 34 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda (P-1) on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 20.09.2018, the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul submitted his report dated 13.12.2018, reporting therein on the basis of the statements of the parties that the compromise arrived at between them is genuine and has been arrived at without any pressure or coercion. The injury under Section 307 IPC on the person of the injured/complainant is also on the non-vital part of his body.

Keeping in view the fact that the parties belong to the same village and that they have amicably settled their rancour against each other and have decided to live with peace and tranquility, I am of the view that continuance of the FIR and consequential proceedings thereof would not be in the interest of the parties. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.72, dated 29.06.2018, registered under Sections 307, 323, 34 IPC and

Section 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda (P-1) along with all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioners.
