Counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was granted concession of bail, however, on account of wrong noting of the date of hearing, petitioner could not appear before the Court on 20.04.2019 and the court issued summons through non-bailable warrants. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would appear before the court within one week and apply for fresh bail.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Bhupener Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this court is of the view that the ends of justice would be met, if the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within one week from today and seek regular bail on furnishing fresh surety/bail bonds. If such an application is filed, the Court would grant concession of regular bail. It may be noted that the petitioner is involved in a case under Section 21 of the NDPS Act for

recovery of 3 gram smack.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the present petition stands disposed of.
