The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.30 dated 11.07.2018, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, at Police Station Women, Patiala.

As per the report of the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court, the mediation remained unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the parties have submitted that the complainant-wife is demanding only the price of the car as the same was sold of at the instance of the petitioner and the petitioner has kept the sale price, and the price of the gold jewellery and this amount comes to Rs.8,00,000/-.

However, learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the petitioner is ready to pay Rs.6,00,000/-. Due to this reason, the matter could not be amicably settled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that more than 11½ tolas gold is still in the possession of the petitioner who is neither returned nor willing to settle the petitioner in his house. He has been keeping her with cruelty

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out. Hence, the instant petition stands dismissed.
