The petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned notice dated 29.03.2019 (Annexure P-7) vide which the selection committee has found all the applicants/candidates including petitioner unsuitable for the post of Deputy Librarian as per advertisement dated 24.04.2018 (Annexure P-1).

Neither any mala-fides are alleged in the writ petition nor even otherwise, it is the case of the petitioner that the selection committee was not empowered to reject the eligible candidates, in case, none of them was found suitable.

In the present case, the petitioner had unsuccessfully participated in the selection process and thereafter has challenged his rejection on the ground that committee ought to have selected at least one candidate and could not have rejected the candidature of all the candidates on the ground that none of them were found

suitable.

Having heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner, I am of the view that neither the advertisement dated 24.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) nor the selection criteria puts any prohibition on the selection committee that in case none of the candidates is found suitable then they must select at least one of them as canvassed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the premise, writ petition is dismissed in limine.
