This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to recover the detenue, namely, Rubina, wife of the petitioner, from the illegal confinement of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion was issued. Respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur was directed to visit the house of private respondents and make enquiry as to whether detenue-Rubina is residing there with her own consent or has been detained by the private respondents illegally and forcibly. If respondent No.3-SHO finds that the detenue has been kept forcibly and against her wishes, then she be produced on the date fixed before this Court. Otherwise, a detailed report be submitted.

Report by way of affidavit of SHO, Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur respondent No.3 has been filed by learned State counsel. Same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel states that detenue Rubina and respondent No.4 Balwant Singh have already filed a protection petition before this Court, which has been allowed by the coordinate Bench vide order dated 28.03.2019. The copy of that petition is also filed on record.

In view of the protection petition and report of learned State counsel, no further action is required in this matter.

Disposed of accordingly.
