Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4 and also directing them not to interfere in the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.3—Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural), is directed to look into the matter, in a time-bound manner.

There is no representation moved on behalf of the petitioners to any of the police authorities. Therefore, instant petition is liable to be dismissed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3— Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) to look into the representation, if any, moved by the petitioners and do the needful, if required, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
