On 30.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Prabhjot Kaur and Raj Kumar, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 26.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to respondent No.2.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 07.05.2019.”

Counsel appearing for the State of Punjab has submitted that the petitioners have given a joint affidavit to the effect that now they do not need any protection. The affidavit is taken on record.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a fresh petition, if in future, there is any threat to their life and liberty.
