Petitioner has sought quashing of order (Annexure P-4), passed by Additional Director General of Police, P.S.P.C.L. He has impugned the order of his reversion to his parent department.

Petitioner was sent on deputation to PSPCL in the year 2015. He was given local rank of ASI in the said Corporation. He has now sought to be reverted to his parent department, where he would get the rank of Head Constable. Learned counsel submits that reversion of the petitioner is arbitrary. Besides, it was incumbent upon the State to consider the petitioner for grant of rank of ASI in terms of policy dated 6.3.2019 (Annexure P-5).

I am not convinced with the plea. The petitioner himself accepted the deputation course where local rank of ASI was given to him. On reversion to his parent cadre, no ground is made out for maintaining the same rank. No argument has been raised as to how the order of reversion is unsustainable. As regards consideration under Policy (Annexure P-5), same

is purely discretion of the authority as per the norms and procedure of the department. Petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
