Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaj Singh, PS Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka submits that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigations and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute. However, learned counsel for the complainant has tried to oppose the same in view of seriousness of the offence.

In the light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 3.10.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
