On 30.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Hemant Kumar and Pratima, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 7 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 to 7. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-6 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 27.04.2019, Annexure P-7 to respondent No.2.

Mr. Sukant Gupta, Addl. P.P. U.T. Chandigarh, appearing for the U.T. Chandigarh is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the counsel appearing on behalf of U.T. Chandigarh during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 07.05.2019.”

In response thereof, a status report has been filed under the signatures of Ranjit Singh, Station House Officer, in which it has been stated that the petitioners have made a statement that now they do not have any threat to their life and liberty. The status report is taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid status report, counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
