On 01.05.2019, following order was passed:-

“The petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent nos.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have made representation dated 26.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, respondent no.2.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent no.2 would examine the

threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. Adjourned to 09.05.2019.”

Counsel appearing on behalf of the State on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, has submitted that the petitioners have appeared before the concerned police official and have got recorded their statements that they do not have any threat to their life and liberty and, therefore, they do not need any protection.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not contacted him after 01.05.2019.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the State, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh one, if in future they apprehends any threat to their life and liberty.
