The petitioner, who is facing trial in FIR No.77 dated 07.04.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Chhachrauli, District Yamuna Nagar, is seeking interim bail for 10 days to enable him to attend 'kirya' ceremony of his mother.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the mother of the petitioner has expired on 22.04.2019 and the 'kirya' ceremony is to be performed on 03.05.2019 and the petitioner is required to be there to make arrangements and perform the rituals connected with the ceremony.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Manish Kumar, states that the 'kirya' ceremony of the mother of the petitioner is indeed slated on 03.05.2019.

In view of the afore-noted circumstances of the case, the present

petition is partly allowed and the petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of three days to enable him to make arrangements and perform the rituals connected with the ceremony and he shall be released on interim bail at 09:00 a.m. on 02.05.2019. The petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, District Jail, Jagadhri on 04.05.2019 at 06:00 p.m. The Superintendent, District Jail, Jagadhri will make suitable arrangement to enable him to attend the 'kirya' ceremony of his mother.
