Present petition is for under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.601 dated 26.12.2016 under Section 420 of IPC and Section 66 of Information Technology Act (Sections 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Khdeki Daula, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. He was not named in the FIR and no role has been attributed to him as his name has cropped up only on the basis of statement of co-accused Suraj. Trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, so, he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel affirmed the period of custody of the petitioner and the fact the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and no role has been attributed to him as his name has cropped up only on the basis of statement of co-accused Suraj; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
