Petitioner Jasmeet Singh has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.78 dated 01.04.2019, registered under Sections 410, 506 IPC and Section 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2008, at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the compromise has been effected between the parties. The copy of the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act as well as the statements of the parties and compromise deed has been filed in connected petition i.e. CRM-M-16961-2019.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 06.05.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
